Rules & Regulations

TENT SITE: There is only one (1) tent per site. Each tent site is limited to 4 adults or 2 adults with 3 children.

RV SITE: There is only one (1) RV per site. Each RV site is limited to 4 adults or 2 adults with 3 children.

SPEED LIMIT: THE SPEED LIMIT THROUGHOUT THE CAMP IS 5 MPH. IT IS STRICTLY ENFORCED!

CYCLES: All children **must wear helmets** while riding a bike, scooter or skateboards. This will be strictly enforced and there will be no exceptions. Cycle riding is not allowed after dusk.

QUIET TIME: Quiet time is from 11:00 PM through 8:00 AM in keeping with the family environment. Campers are asked to refrain from any loud behavior or disturbances during this period. **Minors must be on their site and/or under direct supervision of an adult by 11:00 PM.**

SWIMMING POOL: Please abide by the following rules when using the swimming pool:

- **No lifeguards on duty – swim at your own risk**
- **An adult must accompany all children under the age of 18 while at the pool**
- Observe all signs posted
- Swimming pool will be closed at dusk
- Glass containers and alcohol are not permitted in the swimming pool area
- Pets are not allowed at or in the swimming pool area

CAMPFIRES: Live trees are not to be cut for firewood or for any other reason. All campfires are to be contained in metal fire rings/fire pits to minimize danger. Campers are not to use campfires to burn trash. Campfires must be completely extinguished before retiring for the evening or departing the campground. No fire shall ever be unattended. Please do not put garbage, bottles or cans in the fireplaces.

PETS: **PROOF OF RABIES NEEDS TO BE PROVIDED.** There is a limit of two pets per campsite. All pets must be kept on a leash and never left out of the control of the pet owner at all times. Please dispose of all pet droppings immediately. Please do not tie up pets at site and leave them unattended. Pets are not permitted in public buildings or swim areas. Owners are responsible for the actions of their pets. **Barking dogs will not be tolerated.**

REC HALL: The Rec Hall will be closed at 11:00 PM.

GUESTS: Campers may have a guest visit them. However, they must register at the Front Gate or Office, and are subject to the visitor fee. Campers are responsible for the behavior of their guest. A day guest is entitled to stay until 10:00 PM. An overnight guest must check out no later than 10:00 AM. It is the responsibility of the camper to come to the Office and register the guest. No visitor will be allowed to enter the campground after 9:00 P.M.

IMPROPER BEHAVIOR: For the protection and benefit of all campers and guests, anyone who willfully or negligently destroys or defaces the property of another camper or park property will be held liable for the full value of replacement cost and may be subject to eviction. No firearms, B.B. guns, bow and arrows, slingshots, air guns or fireworks may be discharged or permitted on premises. Further, any individual who violates these guidelines, or by their actions or words disturbs the peace, creates conflict, or otherwise creates a situation not in keeping with the family environment, will be engaging in improper behavior and may be instructed to leave the park.

CHECK IN / OUT: Check in time is 2:00 PM. Early check in time is 11:00 AM at a charge of \$15.00. No check in allowed after 9:00 PM. Check out time is 1:00 PM. Late check out time is 6:00 PM at a charge of \$15.00.

TRASH PICK UP: We do not offer pick up service. Please dispose all garbage in receptacles provided.

PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY: Please provide proper supervision for your children while in the campground. All children must be under direct supervision. Children under 18 years of age must have adult supervision while in the swimming pool/area. Parents will be held responsible for the actions of minor children. **Minors must be on their site and under direct adult supervision by 11:00 PM.**

ALCOHOL POLICY: In keeping with the family environment, excessive use of alcoholic beverages will not be tolerated. Violators will be requested to leave the campground and no refund will be given.

BOATS: The types of boats which are allowed are kayaks and canoes. No rafts permitted. Absolutely no motors of any kind are allowed. All boaters are to abide by the State of Connecticut boating rules and regulations.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- **There will be no refunds for voluntary departure, acts of nature or removal by eviction.**
- This is a family campground and minors under the age of 21 will not be allowed to register to camp without direct adult supervision.
- Disorderly conduct directed toward staff, management or other guests will not be tolerated and will result in immediate termination of camping privileges as well as removal from the campground and no refund will be given.
- No commercial enterprises may be conducted within the campground.
- All campground buildings are non-smoking.
- Cozy Hills Campground owners, management and or its associates are not liable for any damage, theft, or injury to person or property occurring within these premises. Management is not responsible for damage by lightning, electrical surges, or any other act of nature. Therefore, campers should maintain their own personal property and liability insurance.
- The Management reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the campground at their sole discretion.
